Don't err on the side of reporting! California Assembly Bill 617 (AB 617) was signed into law July 2017. Among other things, AB 617 requires the California Air Resources Board (CARB) to develop and implement enhanced emissions reporting of criteria and toxics air pollutants. To meet this requirement, CARB has adopted the Regulation for the Reporting of Criteria Air Pollutants and Toxic Air Contaminants (CTR Regulation), effective January 1, 2020, requiring annual reporting of criteria pollutant and toxic air contaminant emissions from subject facilities. Initial reports for calendar year 2019 are due May 1, 2020.

Who Must Report?

Unless otherwise exempt, facilities meeting one or more of the following criteria must report:

- Facilities subject to CARB's GHG reporting rule, including those that submit abbreviated reports
- Facilities located in a non-attainment area and are permitted to emit 250+ tons per year of any non-attainment pollutant
- Facilities categorized as "high priority" for toxics by the local air district

What Must Be Reported?

Facilities must report actual emissions or provide sufficient activity data so that emissions can be calculated by the local air district. Emissions of criteria pollutants and specified toxics must be reported at the device or process level, including direct and fugitive emissions, for each permitted source. Stack parameters and other device specification must also be reported.
