

# Terraphase Engineering and Science Scholarship Fund Application Submission Guide

## **Step 1: Prepare Your Application Materials**

Before starting the application form, please review this guide so you are able to complete the entire submission process:

#### Step 2: Application Form

✓ Application Form – You will be asked to complete personal, and educational information, including:

- **Eligibility Questionnaire** Confirm your qualifications for the scholarship.
- Applicant Information Personal details including contact information.
- High School Information School name, GPA, and relevant coursework.
- University Information If applicable, details on your college or university.

**Personal Essay and Information** – A written response included within the form with the following prompt:

A personal essay of **500 words or less** which states why you are interested in pursuing a degree related to the environment. Please include statements about what you hope to do with a degree in environmental science or engineering. Other information you may wish to include in your essay: a description of a project or activity you have worked on which was related to the environment; a description of participation in extracurricular activities in which you've participated that may be relevant or show dedication to the environment; or any other reason(s) why you are deserving of this scholarship.

Signature and Confirmation – Final verification and agreement to terms.

• Ensure all required fields are accurately completed before submission.



#### Step 3: Submit Additional Documents via Email

Once you have submitted the online application form, you must email the following documents to **teischolarships@terraphase.com**:

High School Transcript – Must be your most recent transcript, including GPA.

College/University Acceptance Proof (if applicable – may be submitted at later date if acceptance letter has not yet been received) – If you have been accepted, include a copy of your acceptance letter.

### Step 4: Obtain & Submit Two Letters of Recommendation

You are required to provide **at least two** letters of recommendation.

- Letters **must** be written by **non-family members**; letters may be written by teachers, coaches, mentors, supervisors, etc. Note that the Scholarship Fund Selection Committee may request confirmation of authenticity from the author of the recommendation letters.
- Recommenders can submit their letters separately, but they **must be received by the deadline** for your application to be considered.
- You can use and/or forward this link to request letters of recommendation: <u>Submit a</u> <u>Letter of Recommendation</u>.

**important:** Incomplete applications (missing any of the required components) **will not** be considered. Submittal of inaccurate or false information will result in immediate disqualification.

#### **Application Deadline**

- **Submission Deadline: April 15, 2025**
- Mailed Applications: Must be postmarked no later than April 15, 2025.
- Emailed Applications: Must be received by April 15, 2025, 5:00 PM (Pacific Standard Time).
- **1** Late applications will NOT be considered.
